

David A. Scotti focuses his practice in the areas of construction law, complex commercial litigation and real estate with an emphasis in construction litigation, construction contracts and project counseling. Mr. Scotti has represented owners, developers, architects, engineers, EPC contractors, general contractors and subcontractors on a wide variety of construction projects including power plants, steel plants, dams, bridges, roads, aerial tramways, hospitals, prisons, sports stadiums, schools, churches, office buildings, public housing, mixed-use developments and housing developments. He has extensive experience in drafting and negotiating design and construction contracts and in providing project counseling regarding dispute avoidance. Mr. Scotti has represented clients regarding both domestic and international disputes in federal and state trial and appellate courts, the Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals, the Pennsylvania Board of Claims, the International Chamber of Commerce, the International Centre for Dispute Resolution and the American Arbitration Association. He has concentrated his practice in the area of construction law for over 25 years.

Mr. Scotti has served as an arbitrator and mediator on a broad range of construction projects. He is a member of the National Panel of Arbitrators for the Amelican Arbitration Association and has served as a construction arbitrator since 1990 and as a mediator since 1994. Mr. Scotti has authored articles and seminar materials on construction law and has delivered numerous educational presentations on a variety of topics related to the construction industry. He has lectured for the American Bar Association Forum on the Construction Industry, the Associated General Contractors of America, International Construction Super Conference, Tri-State Construction Users Council, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and the Conference of Catholic Facility Managers.

Mr. Scotti has been appointed to the Governing Committee of the ABA Forum on the Construction Industry. He served as chairman of the Contract Documents Division of the ABA Forum on the Construction h1dustry from April 2008 to April 2010. He has twice served on the Steering Committee of the Contract Documents Division and was invited to provide comment on the drafting of the AJA A201 General Conditions for both the 1997 and 2007 editions. Mr. Scotti serves as the legal representative for a joint committee of the Pittsburgh Chapters of the American Institute of Architects and the Associated General Contractors of America. He is a member of the Construction Law Section of the Allegheny County Bar Association and an affiliate member of the Master Builders Association of Western Pennsylvania. In 2013 and 2014, he was selected as a Pem1sylvania Super Lawyer for Construction Litigation.
